**1. To Parents / Guardians of Junior members**

- The Club warns that, in accordance with By-law 3.2.5, that the Rescue Boat service will only be available during scheduled and organized activities. Outside these times parents/guardians are responsible for their children or wards and must appreciate that the Club cannot be expected to exercise supervision or control.
- Even during organized Club racing/training the Club cannot accept responsibility for children, or any other person, not engaged in organized racing/training.
- Even during racing/training there can be an element of risk and junior members should be encouraged to treat the water with respect, especially in stormy and wintry conditions. The club can give no absolute guarantee of safety, although the Club's record is unblemished for more than 80 years.
- We would also stress the need for proper clothing for the prevailing conditions, kept in good condition, especially personal flotation devices (*buoyancy aids in old money*) and (for times when the water is cold) wet or dry suits,
- To protect the Club and to be sure that parents/guardians are aware of their liabilities it is necessary to ask you to sign to that effect when you send this renewal form to the Membership Secretary.
- Your attention is drawn to By-law 3.2.5 which states that Junior members without R.Y.A. Level 3 (dinghies) or R.Y.A. Level 2 (sailboard) are not permitted to sail on the water unless either the Rescue Boat is operational or they are accompanied on the water by a Senior member.
- A Junior member must have at least one parent or legal guardian who is a Family, Senior or Associate member of the Club.
